

# How to Separate Household Waste

- ◆Three Principles of Garbage Disposal◆
- 1 Place your garbage outside by 8:00 a.m. on the appointed day!
  - 2 Place it in the designated spot!
  - 3 Please separate your waste into its designated bag!

Sorting and Disposing	List of Items 【Please make sure to put their items in their designated bags according to classification.】	
<p><b>Burnable Garbage</b> "可燃ごみ" Semi-transparent designated bags. Garbage in excess of three bags must be brought directly to the collection facility.</p>	<p>Kitchen waste → Drain any water</p> <p>Stuffed animals and toys</p> <p>CDs, DVDs, and other discs</p> <p>Shoes, slippers, etc.</p> <p>Cat and dog's litter</p> <p>Grasses, branches, etc.</p>	
<p><b>PET Bottles</b> "ペットボトル" Green designated bags.</p>	<p>Items with this Mark</p> <p>Plastic containers for water, juice, soda, alcoholic beverages, soy sauce, etc.</p> <p>◆Be sure to remove the cap and label, rinse the inside of the bottle.</p> <p>※Be sure to remove the cap and label from PET bottles before disposing of them.</p>	
<p><b>Plastic Mark</b> "プラマーク" Place in a transparent or translucent bags.</p>	<p>Items with this Mark</p> <p>Packing items with the "Plastic" mark, trays, Styrofoam, etc.</p> <p>Please use 20 to 40 liter transparent or translucent bags.</p> <p>※Items with a "Plastic" mark but dirty should be put out as burnable garbage.</p>	
<p><b>Empty Bottles and Empty Cans</b> "ビン・カン" Yellow designated bags.</p>	<p>Empty the contents of bottles and cans and rinse them with water before recycling.</p> <p>Metal candy containers, milk cans</p> <p>Seasoning containers, etc.</p> <p>Use up spray cans, cassette cylinders, etc. And put them in a transparent or translucent plastic bag. Dispose of them separately.</p>	
<p><b>Paper Product</b> "紙類" Tie them together crosswise with twice or put them in a paper bag.</p>	<p>●Please bundle paper by type.</p> <p>Rinse, open, flatten, and bundle</p> <p>Cardboard</p> <p>Milk cartons</p> <p>Old newspapers</p> <p>Old magazines</p> <p>Wrapping paper, advertisements, paper bags, candy boxes, copy paper, and other miscellaneous paper</p> <p>※If the inside of the carton is metal coating, please dispose of it as burnable garbage. ※Do not use plastic bags.</p>	
<p><b>Clothing and cloths</b> "衣類・布類" Place in a transparent or translucent bags.</p>	<p>Clothing</p> <p>●Please put them in a transparent or translucent bag to prevent them from getting wet. If they get wet, they cannot be recycled.</p> <p>Futons, blankets, down jackets</p> <p>Blankets and futons should be disposed of as large burnable garbage. (Burnable garbage if put in a bag.)</p>	
<p><b>Unburnable Garbage</b> Garbage in excess of 3 bags must be brought directly to the facility. "不燃ごみ" Glass, Ceramics, etc. • Metal Products • Electrical Products Red designated bags.</p>	<p>Vases</p> <p>Teacups, flowerpots</p> <p>Ski equipment and boots</p> <p>Pot, Kettle, etc.</p> <p>Metal tableware, knives, cutlery</p> <p>Umbrellas</p> <p>Glass plates and cups</p> <p>DVD deck</p> <p>Gas stoves</p> <p>Bicycles</p> <p>Dry battery, Fluorescent lamp</p> <p>Put dry batteries and fluorescent lamp in a transparent or translucent bag and dispose of them separately.</p> <p>※Sharp and dangerous items such as knives, scissors, razors, light bulbs, broken glass, etc. should be wrapped in paper and placed in a designated bag before being taken out. ※Please use up lighter before taking it out. ※Be sure to empty the fuel out of the stove before putting it out. ※For rechargeable batteries and button cell batteries, contact your dealer. ※Please clearly mark any items that do not fit in the bag garbage. ※Separate metal from other objects.</p>	
<p><b>Large Burnable Garbage</b> "大型可燃ごみ"</p>	<p>Desks, Chairs</p> <p>Drawers</p> <p>Drawers, desks, chairs, etc. will be broken and tied up.</p> <p>Fusuma, Shoji</p> <p>Kotatsu board</p> <p>Tree trunks that do not fit in bags</p> <p>※Futons, tree trunks, etc. can be bundled up to 3 bundles at a time. ※Please remove mirrors and metal items from the wardrobe and dispose of them as Unburnable Garbage. ※If you have a large amount, please bring it directly to the facility.</p>	
<p><b>landfill garbage</b> "埋立ごみ" Place in a transparent or translucent bags.</p>	<p>Pickle stone, concrete products such as drying rack's base</p> <p>●The amount that can be put out to the station is up to 10kg per bag, up to 3 bags.</p> <p>Blankets, Futons, Carpets</p> <p>Within 100cm in length</p>	
<p><b>What can't Be Processed</b></p> <p>※These cannot be processed at a facility. Ask your dealer or a specialist.</p> <p>Bathtubs</p> <p>Tires</p> <p>Cans with residual contents</p> <p>Toxic chemicals and their containers</p> <p>Fire extinguishers</p> <p>Fireproof safes</p> <p>Batteries</p> <p>Massage chairs</p>	<p><b>Personal Computer</b></p> <p>Apply to the manufacturer in accordance with the rules for promoting effective resource use.</p> <p><b>Home Appliances Categories</b></p> <p>Cannot be processed at the facility.</p> <p>Washing machines</p> <p>Air conditioners and outside units</p> <p>Clothes dryers</p> <p>Refrigerators, Freezers</p> <p>Plasma TVs, LCS TVs</p> <p>TVs</p> <p><b>Things to bring in directly</b></p> <p>Please separate metal items from other items.</p> <p>Mattresses, sofas</p> <p>Disassemble into metal and other objects.</p> <p>Tatami mats less than 10 sheets</p>	<p><b>To stores, etc. in accordance with the Home Appliance Recycling Law</b></p>
